CONSTITUTION ON SOVEREIGNTY TO THE PARLIAMENT, GOVERNMENT AND
PEOPLE OF THE BOLIVARIAN REPUBLIC OF VENEZUELA**

The President of the House of Senate of the Parliament of Grenada, Senator the Honourable Chester Arlington Arthur Humphrey, as well as all other Senators convey their profound compliments and best wishes to Your Excellency Diosdado Cabello Rondon and members of the National Assembly of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.

Senator Humphrey writes pursuant to the above captioned subject matter and expresses the collective concerns over reports of plans to effect a coup d'état against the democratically elected and popular government of His Excellency President Nicholas Maduro. Such a development poses a grave danger to the people and sovereignty of the Bolivarian Republic and amounts to a grave assault against the Constitution - a matter which must concern all democratically minded people and is of particular concern to the Senators in the Parliament of Grenada.

Your Excellency, Grenada and Venezuela have shared a long history of relations going back for more than a century but has witnessed a qualitative improvement in those relations since the coming into office of the late illustrious President His Excellency Hugo Chavez. Grenada and Venezuela have benefited tremendously from the development of these relationships and it is our firmest desire to work assiduously on strengthening those relations.

We therefore take the opportunity to express our solidarity and support to the Parliament, Government and People of Venezuela and to condemn in the strongest terms any attempt, or any assault on the democratically elected Government, or any action which violates the Constitution of the Republic.
